Introduction

This guide defines all parameters of the Niseko Visual Identity and is written to ensure the correct presentation of the Niseko nameplate and corporate style.

The Niseko Master Artwork CDs and DVDs contain master nameplates and digital artwork templates for all items presented in this manual.

The Niseko visual identity and its elements have been specifically designed to reflect its individuality while maintaining a unified style for Niseko.

Nameplates should be used where possible, as a symbol to identify Niseko. The nameplates combined with the way in which they are presented is the essence of Niseko Visual Identity. Consistency of style, the way in which Niseko communication material is laid out, completes the identity and ensures a professional and recognisable image for the brand.

Only the combinations of the Niseko nameplate and styles shown in this style guide are acceptable.

Always use the master digital files from the CDs and DVDs and refer to the appropriate pages in this style guide for detailed information about the correct reproduction of these images.

Ensure any person producing artwork for Niseko is given this style guide as well as the digital masters from the CDs and DVDs.

Primary Nameplate Version B



Primary Nameplate Version B: Clear Space

Always allow clear space around each nameplate at all times.
This space should always be at least the width of the letter “n” of the nameplate at the size that it is to appear.



Primary Nameplate Version B: Minimum Size

To ensure optimum legibility, the Niseko nameplate, including its clear space, must never appear smaller than 30mm width.



Primary Nameplate Version B: Preferred colour and background options

If the nameplate must appear on a coloured background, the following examples are the preferred options.

If the nameplate appears over an image background, it should be reversed out of a dark image background, or set in full colour or solid black over a light image background.
